

2022 WBR NEW Commissioner Training Class

Elections are run by many groups with different responsibilities: Secretary of State (Warehouse Employees, Drayman), Registrar of Voters, Clerk of Court, Parish Board of Election Supervisors, and YOU (CIC, Commissioners, Custodians)

Qualifications for commissioners and alternate commissioners are to

1. be a qualified voter or a 17-year-old in 12th grade, who is able to perform the essential duties described in this pamphlet;
2. not be a candidate in the election or a child, child's spouse, brother, brother's spouse, sister, sister's spouse, parent, spouse, or parents of the spouse of a candidate in the precinct where serving;
3. be registered to vote in the precinct of the ward or precinct of the parish serving, if no wards exist, unless replacements are necessary;
4. not have been convicted of an election offense;
5. not be a law enforcement officer; and
6. attend training and successfully pass at least 10 questions of a 15 question test.
