Current CMP Pistol rules will govern: *Competitors are responsible for being aware of the Match Program and all safety regulations contained in the CMP rulebook. Triggers may be weighed.*

Entries: Do not prepay for the match, entries and fees will be accepted day of the match.

Eligibility: Open to all eligible participants, no affiliation or membership required.

CMP Liability Release: A release must be on file with the CMP. If you need to complete a release form, you can find one at <http://thecmp.org/wp-content/uploads/affidavit.pdf>

Match Fees: EIC .22 Rimfire Pistol - \$20 EIC Service Pistol - \$20 EIC Service Revolver - \$20

Schedule of Events: Check-in is at 8:30 am for Relay One, Check-in is at 11:30 for Relay Two.

Firing begins at 9am for Relay One and 12pm for Relay Two. All three pistol matches may be entered, they will be fired sequentially for each relay with .22 rimfire first. CMP Competition Rule 4.1.2 for .22 Rimfire pistol requirements. CMP Rule 4.1.1 for authorized Centerfire service pistol requirements. CMP Rule 4.1.3 for authorized service Revolver requirements.

Course of Fire for .22 Rimfire and Centerfire: Table 4 - 30 round Pistol National Match Course

Course of Fire for Revolver: Table 3 – 40 round Presidents Pistol Match Course

Ammunition: Rule 4.4 use any safe ammunition for Rimfire, Centerfire and Revolver pistols. Competitor must supply own ammo.

Classifications: CMP classifications will be used.

Challenges: A \$2 Challenge Fee will be charged for lost challenges. Scores may only be challenged prior to awards.

AWARDS

- CMP EIC matches: Awards will be determined and awarded by the CMP pending the review of match results. Achievement Pins will be awarded based on CMP cutoff scores.
- Final Results: Results from all matches will be posted on the Club's website at <http://www.paloaltogunclub.com>.

Highlighted Safety Notes – competitor is responsible for adhering to **ALL** published CMP rules and Palo Alto range safety rules including as follows:

- The use of an empty chamber indicator (ECI) is required even while the firearm is in the case. Only during a preparation period or actual firing may the ECI be removed.
- Magazines may be inserted and EIC removed only during the preparation period or live firing.
- All brass must be policed.
- **CMP Rule 3.6.2 Eye and Hearing Protection:** All competitors and competition officials, including Scorers or Verifiers, are required to wear eye and hearing protection when on the firing line during CMP competitions. See rule book for further specifics on eye protection dimensions and proper wear.

¹When this course of fire is fired with .22 Rimfire Pistols as a National Trophy or EIC Match, timed and rapid-fire series must start from the 45-degree angle ready position (Rule 5.1.1 b).

9.3.8 EIC Minimum Credit Scores

To receive EIC credit points, the score fired by the competitor must fulfill the requirements of Rule 9.3.7 (*top 10%, etc.*) and equal or exceed the EIC Minimum Credit Score (MCS) for that discipline. Minimum Credit Scores are:

- a) Service Pistol: 250 x 300
- b) .22 Rimfire Pistol: 260 x 300
- c) Service Revolver: 315 x 400

CMP Liability release form must be on file or a new one presented at registration
